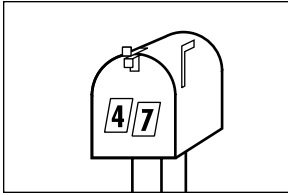


# Ways to Use Numbers

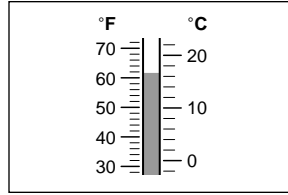
Numbers can be used to locate, to name, to measure, and to count.



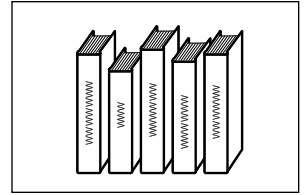
Locate



Name

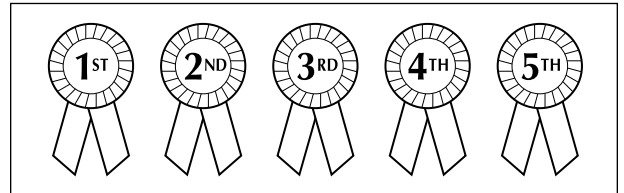


Measure

Numbers can also be used to show the order of people or objects. These are called ordinal numbers.



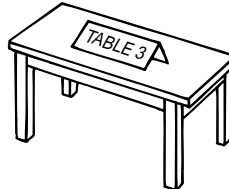

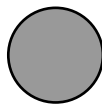

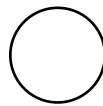
