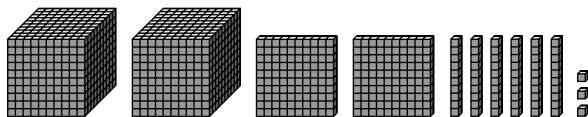


Numbers in the Thousands
